MOTHS FOR BEGINNERS : PART 1

COMMON MACROMOTHS BY WING COLOUR

Common species in the Upper Thames area are illustrated, along with the months in which they fly. All moths are shown in their resting positions unless otherwise stated. Again, moths are shown in the order found in the Field Guides.




*There are two very similar species - the Five-spot Burnet and the more common Narrow-bordered Five-spot Burnet (see Field Guide).

**It is difficult to distinguish the Red Twin-spot Carpet from the red form of the Dark-barred Twinspot Carpet, now rare in our region.
